



OVERVIEW

Bhutan Bird Festival is annual event for Zhemgang Dzongkhag and a signature event to promote community-based ecotourism. A total of 11 events are identified for BBF 2019 and cycling is one such event to be held with the objectives to:

- Promote Ecotourism in the region
- Enhance healthy living through encouragement in hobby of bird watching and cycling
- Establish sustainable fund for BBF to protect endemic/threatened bird species of the country and promote wildlife and environmental conservation in long run



EVENT SCHEDULE

- Date: 12th November 2019 (Second day of the BBF 2019)
- Time: 0730 1530 Hrs
- Start & End Points : Tingtibi Town
- Two categories : Male and Female Category but need minimum 35 riders in each category

ROUTE DETAILS

- Circular route (See Route Map overleaf)
- Main routes start and end from/at: Tingtibi Town Tingtibi Chorten Junction Bermo Botanical Garden Wangdigang/Trongsa Junction Zhemgang Town Dakphel/Buli Junction Tingtibi Bridge Tingtibi BOD Goling/Panbang Junction Yebilaptsa School Junction Yebilaptsa/Gelephu Junction Tingtibi Town
- Approximately 85 km (52.8 miles)
- Tropical and sub-tropical terrains mixed with up-hill and down-hill rides and some stretch of rough and dusty trails

Open on 9th and 10th November 2019 with prior information to Event Manager
