Minutes:

- 1) The meeting directed the secretariat to summarize and further disseminate the contents of press release of PMO on 19th June 2020, Moving forward: In transition to a new-normal.
- 2) The meeting decided to review and further strengthen the quarantine and isolation facilities within a week spearheaded by logistic team.
- 3) The meeting decided that the Task Force should supervise the preparedness and monitor the implementation of school specific COVID-19 plan in the wake of school reopening. Meeting also decided to conduct review visit to schools every after two weeks.
- 4) The meeting directed the secretariat to update and prepare a comprehensive report of Dzongkhag's Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan for COVID-19.

- 5) Meeting recommended the Health Sector to liaise with MoH and suggest to come up with measures and strategies to monitor those individuals who have completed the quarantine and isolation period entering and residing in Zhemgang Dzongkhag.
- 6) The meeting also directed the Secretariat to explore alternatives for school facilities currently used either as quarantine or storage facilities in consultation with the agencies concerned.
- 7) The meeting also recommended to conduct mock drill for COVID-19 preparedness in Zhemgang and Yebilaptsa hospitals.
